



- 5. Domicile Certificate of Punjab. Candidates having a domicile of Islamabad (ICT) are eligible to apply on open merit.
 - For the tribal seat, the candidate should have a Domicile Certificate of the tribal area of Dera Ghazi Khan, Punjab.
 - Other certificates or documents (e.g., Birth Certificate, Form-B, CNIC or Passport, etc.) are unacceptable in lieu of a
 Domicile Certificate. Any candidate found to have a domicile of more than one place shall be disqualified.
- **6.** Character Certificate from the institution last attended.
- 7. CNIC/ CRC or Form-B/ NICOP/ POC or Passport of the candidate.
- 8. CNIC/ NICOP/ POC or Passport of the father or the guardian.
- **9.** Four recent passport-size photographs with white backgrounds. One photograph should be attested on the front and the other three should be attested on the back.
- 10. Original Fitness Certificate issued by a registered Government Medical Practitioner Officer indicating the PM&DC number of doctor.
- 11. Disability Certificate issued by "Provisional Council for The Rehabilitation of Disabled Persons" only for disabled candidates.
- **12.** If you are applying for the employee seat, attach the Family Registration Certificate (FRC) issued by NADRA and the Regular Employee Certificate of the guardian/ spouse issued by the competent authority.

NOTE:

- 1. The allocation of seats will be purely on a merit basis. The decision of the Admission Board shall be final.
- 2. There are sixty seats in total (20 seats for each degree program mentioned above)
- 3. 02 Seats (one in MIT and one in MLT) out of a total 60 seats are reserved for disabled candidats
- 4. 01 Seat (in OTT) out of a total 60 seats is reserved for the Tribal Quota of Dera Ghazi Khan.
- 5. 03 Seats (one in MIT, one in MLT, and one in OTT) out of a total of 60 seats are reserved for children/spouses of Regular Employees working at D. G. Khan Medical College and Allama Iqbal Teaching Hospital, Dera Ghazi Khan.
- 6. The Merit Lists and Selection Lists will be made strictly on a merit basis in the light of Admission Criteria and the Rules and regulations laid down by the University of Health Sciences (UHS) and the Government of Punjab.
- 7. The Merit lists for disabled candidates, tribal quota, and, employee quota shall be made on the basis of inter se merit
- 8. The course fee once paid by the candidates after securing the admissions will not be refunded once the registration with the University of Health Sciences is done.
- **9.** There is no hostel facility for the Institute of Allied Health Sciences students.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ATTENDANCE

- Attendance of lectures and practical are compulsory. Students with less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear for University examinations.
- Every students is required to be punctual at the hours notified for lecturers, rotations and practical classes:

DRESS CODE

- White coat designed by the instutie is compulsory for all Students
- Students are expected to dress up decently and they should observe simplicity.
- Students should have white overalls during their rotation in labs.

IDENTITY CARD

- It is compulsory for all students to obtain his/her identity card from IAHS office immediately after his/her admission.
- Student should always display his/her identity card at all times.

LEAVE

- Planned leaves must be approved by principal before availing leave.
- Sick leave will only be granted on provision of Medical Certificate form and authorized Medical Officer.
- In all cases leave taken will be at student's own risk so far as the percentage of attendance is concerned and even medical certificate will not condone if deficiency in attendance.

MIGRATION RULES

■ The students may apply for migration from 2nd year onward as per rules / policy framed by UHS Lahore & Govt. of Punjab.

REMISSION OF FEE

- a) Remission of fee will be allowed by the Head of the Institution up to 10% of all students belonging to Punjab excluding remanded (including detained or expelled) students (two half fee concessions are equivalent to one full fe remission). Remission of fee means only tuition fee. no other fee or fund will be refunded.
- b) Remanded (Including detained and expelled) students will not be entitled for fee concession practical classes:
- Application for fee remission must be submitted by the candidates along with statement from First Class Magistrate stating the financial position of the applicant's parent/guardian and from the head of the department. Fresh applications will be required every year.
- d) The grant of such remission will rest with the head of the institution and will be depend upon the financial condition, general conduct, work and progress of the students. Absence from failure in professional or house examination, breach of discipline, neglect of studies or irresponsible conduct shall entail the loss of the concession.
- e) Any students who leaves the institution with the object on continuing his/her studies elsewhere may receive certificate of attendance and lectures on payment of fee at the following rates:
 - i) case of registered students who have passed the University Professional Examination, in the subject for which certificates Rs. 100/- for a combined certificate embracing all, and Rs.30/- for certificate for one subject.
 - ii) In case of registered students who have failed to qualify the University Professional Examination fee is Rs. 100/- for each period of hospital instruction.

REFUND OF FEE

- i) Where a students's has deposit fee and joins or does not join classes but within fifteen working days on the commencement of classes, inform in working the medical and dental institution and the university that he/she wishes to leave the institution, his/her seat shall be deemed to have become vacant upon furnishing of this information and he shall be entitled to hundred percent refund of all his deposit fees and charges, except one-time admission fee and a student from waiting list may be admitted against this vacant seat in accordance with merit.
- Where the student who has paid fee and join classes opts for a private sector medical or dental institution within three months during same admission procedure, that the students shall be entitled for refund of fee after deduction of fee for study period availed in terms of months in that medical or dental institution and the seat shall be considered as vacant No fee shall be refunded after three months of commencement of classes. A student from waiting list may be admitted against this vacant seat in accordance with merit.
- Where a student is migrated from one medical or dental institution to another medical or dental institution at nay stage of the academic seccion, the medical or dental institution as the case may be shall be bound to refund all dues and fee charged proportionate to remaining period of academic year.

DETAINEE STUDENTS FEE

According to the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council, "the Executive Committee decided that the fee charged to the detainee students shall be one third (1/3) of the total annual tuition fee as PM&DC regulation (for each failed subject). In case if students is failed in all subject 75% of annual tuition fee shall be charged. "This may be approved for Allied Health Sciences Students."

MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY B.Sc. (Hons.) MLT













AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- The aims of this program is to equip the students with relevant professional knowledge, skills, techniques and ethical values.
- To assess the technical and no technical skills in a standardized and reproducible environment
- To develop and analyze innovative strategies for effective communication with the patients.

WHO IS A MEDICAL LAB. TECHNOLOGIST?

Medical Laboratory Technologists perform chemical or visual analysis of specimen taken from body fluids to identify, quantify, verify and report the presence or absence of chemicals, micro-organisms, proteins, other substance and the description of cellular elements in clinical laboratory.

Personal attributes for medical technologist should include manual dexterity, strong sense of responsibility the ability to work with others and attentiveness.

THE DEPARTMENT OF PATHOLOGY

OPERATION THEATER TECHNOLOGY B.Sc. (Hons.) OTT





AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The aims of the 4 years degree program in Operation Theater Technology is to equipment the students with relevant professional knowledge, skills, techniques and ethical values to enable them to apply their acquired expertise at level between the doctors and the patient for efficient health service delivery.

WHO IS OPERATION THEATER TECHNOLOGIST?

The operation Theater Technologist participate in the assessment of patients prior to surgery and provide indivualized care. An ability to communicate and work effectively within a team is essential. The OTTs role also involves many clinical skill such as preparation of vide range of specialists, equipments and drugs. These include all related instruments used in operation theater.

ROLE OF OPERATION THEATER TECHNOLOGIST

Operation Theater Technologists provide high standards of patient care and skilled support alongside medical and nursing colleagues during the anaesthetic surgical and recovery phase of pre and post operative period. The OTT is therefore required to have a board Knowledge and skill in addition to management and communication skills.

i. THE ANESTHETIC PHASE

This involves supporting the patient through anxious time but before the patient arrives in theater, OTTs prepare a wide range of specialist equipments and drugs that will be required For the safety of patients during anaesthesia.













ii. THE SURGICAL PHASE

Patient care remains the focus throughout the surgical phase and OTTs undertake, as part the operativeteam, a number of roles including the scrubbed role, application of aseptic technique, wound management and infection control. Wearing sterile gowns and gloves having prepared all the necessary instrument & equipments for the procedure, they work along the surgeon.

iii. RECOVERY PHASE

OTTs receive, asses and deliver patient care within the recovery unit. They monitor the patient's physiological parameters and support them, providing appropriate intervention and treatment, until the patient has recovered from the effects of anaesthesia and surgery and is stable.

CAREER

Operation Theater Technologists are a vital part of clinical team and provide professional expertise during the patient's stay in hospital. OTTs are primarily employed within the operation theatres, they are increasingly being recognized for their skills in other critical care areas.
